

Scenic Route to Ocean City Music Pier

801 Boardwalk, Ocean City, NJ

From West Chester:

- Take Route 202 South to Rte 1 North/Rte 322 South. Stay on Rte 322 through Chester.
- Cross over I-95 (I hate this part- it's tricky- merging from left side and crossing over 4 lanes of traffic. I always pray.....)
- Take the Commodore Barry Bridge to New Jersey.
- Stay on Rte 322 until Glassboro.
- Hop onto Rte 55 South. Stay on Rte 55 until Millville , you will see a huge water tower on the left.
- Take the exit for Rte 49 East. Stay on this until the dead end at Rte 50 in Tuckahoe.
- Turn right onto Rte 50 South. If time, stop into the Tuckahoe Cheesecake Factory (on the left after the turn) and buy yourself a carrot cake. For \$27 it is worth every penny.
- Stay on this until you see our favorite Biker Bar, the Triton Tavern.
- Make the left (at the light) onto Rte 631 East. You are now about 20 minutes away from Ocean City.
- At some point, Rte 631 veers right - you should STAY STRAIGHT. Follow the signs for Ocean City.
- Stay on this road until you get to Ocean City. You will cross a bridge, it will smell like the ocean, you'll hear seagulls.
- Rte 631 turns into 34th Street. Stay on 34th street.
- Turn left at the light onto Bay Avenue.
- Stay on Bay Avenue until 9th Street.
- Make a right onto 9th Street and head towards the ocean. Park in the lots near the boardwalk.
- Takes almost exactly 2 hours from West Chester.
- If you need lunch, stop at Primo Hoagies at 656 Asbury Avenue (609) 399-7746. Get the Badda Bing (chicken cutlet with sharp provolone and broccoli rabe).
